

How to Reach Miri Piri Retreat Center

This document has instructions on how to reach Miri Piri by car, as well as by public transport.

We are happy to help you connect with other participants, so that you can organize traveling together.

Where is Miri Piri Retreat Center

Miri Piri is located near Piacenza, in the Emilia-Romagna region in Italy. Approx. 1 hour from Milan. Address is:

Miri Piri Seminar house, Loc. Sborzani, hamlet of Pigazzano, Municipality of Travo, Italy.

If you fly to Milan

There are several airports in Milan, the one closest to the venue is **Milan Linate**.

Taxi from airport

From **Milan Linate** or **Bergamo Orio al Serio**, a direct taxi to Miri Piri costs approx. €200.

By public transport from airport

The easiest way to reach us is to travel to **Piacenza railway station** and continue from there by taxi. Otherwise, you can take a taxi directly from the airport.

1. Airports with the Best Train Connections to Piacenza

- **Milan Linate (LIN):** Shuttle bus to Milano Centrale (25–30 min), then train to Piacenza (45–60 min).
- **Milan Malpensa (MXP):** Malpensa Express train to Milano Centrale (50 min), then train to Piacenza (45–60 min).
- **Milan Bergamo Orio al Serio (BGY):** Shuttle bus to Milano Centrale (1 h), then train to Piacenza (45–60 min).
- **Bologna (BLQ):** Airport shuttle train to Bologna Centrale (10 min), then train to Piacenza (1 h 15 min).
- **Genoa (GOA):** Train from Genova Piazza Principe to Piacenza (1 h 30 min).

2. From Piacenza Station to Miri Piri

We have a **taxi agreement** with Mr. Carlo (+39 339 6346958).

- Cost: €60 per ride (up to 4 passengers).

How to Reach Miri Piri by Car

An 11 kWh electric vehicle charging station is available on site.

Standard Route

- Take the **A1 motorway** and **exit at Piacenza Sud**.
- Continue along the **Tangenziale (ring road)** and follow signs for **SS45 Genova–Bobbio**.
- Just after **Rivergaro**, turn **right** toward **Rivalta–Croara**.
- After about **1 km**, turn **right again** toward **Pigazzano**.
- In **Pigazzano**, turn **right** in front of the bar.
- After **500 m**, turn **left** toward **Sborzani**.
- Continue for another **1.5 km** (the last **900 m** are on an unpaved road).

Total driving time: approximately **1 hour** from Milan.

Scenic Route

Same distance and travel time as the standard route.

- Take the **A1 motorway** and **exit at Piacenza Sud**.
- Continue along the **Tangenziale**, then follow **SS45 Genova–Bobbio**.
- At the large roundabout (“**Galleana**” roundabout), take the **2nd exit** toward **Gossolengo–Agazzano**.
- After **600 m**, turn **right** for **Gossolengo**.
- At the next roundabout, turn **left** for **Agazzano**.
- At the “**Besurica**” roundabout, go **straight** toward **Gossolengo–Rivalta–Rivergaro**.
- After **4.5 km**, at the roundabout go **straight** toward **Rivergaro**.
- After **4 km**, turn **right** toward **Piozzano–Agazzano–Gazzola**.
- After crossing the **Trebbia River bridge**, turn **left** for **Piozzano–Agazzano–Gazzola**.
- After **1.3 km**, at the junction continue **straight**.
- After **5 km**, turn **right** for **Scrivellano–Pigazzano**.
- At the junction for **Scrivellano**, continue **straight** for **Pigazzano**.
- Upon arriving in **Pigazzano**, continue **uphill**, then after **500 m**, turn **left** for **Sborzani–Miri Piri**.
- After **600 m**, at the junction, turn **right** for **Sborzani–Miri Piri**.
- The last **900 m** are on an **unpaved road**.

Travel time: same as the standard route, but with more scenic countryside views.

From Turin

- Take the **A21 motorway** and **exit at Piacenza Ovest**.
- Follow signs for “**Valli Piacentine**”.
- You’ll join the **Scenic Route** described above
